- Ensuring that all our activities are being carried out according to our internal policies and procedures;
- Requiring all employees to exercise personal responsibility in preventing harm to him or herself and others, enabling each to consult and contribute to safety and health;
- Promoting the exchange of information on safety and health, to all employees, non-employees and to public authorities;
- Communicating openly on our policies and the nature of our activities and reporting generally our progress on safety and health performances;
- Managing and promoting health and safety as an integral part of the responsibilities of all Managers, Supervisors and Site Responsible Persons, together with employing an internal competent adviser;
- Ensuring that Directors and Senior Managers of the Company are aware of their obligations and responsibilities for health and safety matters and are aware of changes in the relevant legislation and conduct an annual review of the Company's policy to ensure compliance.
